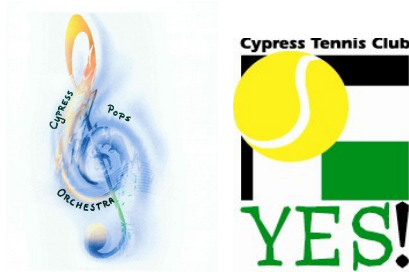

Tournament only: Participation for one player in one division of the tennis tournament which includes goody bag and a commemorative T-shirt.

Tournament & Banquet: Participation in tournament and banquet as shown above.

No refunds after names are placed in the draw. Teams must check in 30 minutes prior to their match. Draws will be limited to 16 players (8 teams) per division.

Default: A 15-minute default time will be enforced. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Each team will be allowed 5 minutes for warm-up prior to the match.

In Case of Rain: No refunds for inclement weather.
